READ CAREFULLY

I CERTIFY that I understand and will be guided by the provisions of the Fire Protection & Emergency Response Bylaw and all applicable Provincial and Federal laws and regulations in force from time to time and any conditions or restrictions imposed in the permit by the Fire Chief.

IN CONSIDERATION of \$5.00 and other good and valuable consideration (the receipt and sufficiency of which I acknowledge), I covenant that I will indemnify and save harmless the District and its elected officials, employees, officers, agents and contractors from and against any and all manner of actions or causes of action, damages, costs, loss or expenses of whatever kind (including, without limitation, legal fees) which the District or its elected officials, employees, officers, agents or contractors may sustain, incur, or be put to by reason of or arising out of:

- a) issuance of this permit;
- b) the fireworks event, including, without limitation, the handling, storage, firing, setting off, exploding or other use of fireworks in connection therewith;
- c) my use or occupation of the location upon which the sale or fireworks event is to occur; or
- d) any act or omission of myself or any person for whom I am, at law, responsible, including without limitation, the non-observance or non-performance of any obligation imposed by federal or provincial law

I also acknowledge that I will use fireworks on private property in a responsible and safe manner in conformance with the manufacturer's instructions, Fire Services Guidelines (see reverse) and the Fire Protection and Emergency Response Bylaw.

PERMISSION IS GRANTED to the above Applicant to fire, set off or explode fireworks, in the location and at the date and time set out above, subject to the Fire Protection & Emergency Response Bylaw, as amended from time to time. If Applicant is to fire, set off or explode fireworks on public property the following conditions and restrictions will also apply:

- In accordance with requirements of the Fire Protection & Emergency Response Bylaw, the applicant shall obtain Comprehensive General Liability insurance policy with an inclusive limit of not less than \$5,000,000 per occurrence for bodily injury and property damage and provide evidence of the same to the Fire Chief or his designate no later than 3 days prior to the fireworks event.
- This permit is not transferable. Only the Applicant is authorized under this permit to fire or set off fireworks.
- The Applicant may fire or set off only the fireworks described above.
- The Applicant must ensure that all debris and litter related to the fireworks event, including any litter left by the spectators, is removed from the location at the conclusion of the fireworks display.

I have determined that the person named above is over 18 years of age and has stated the fireworks are for their own use.
