**Subject:** Traffic concerns - Hadden Drive and Mathers Avenue

Dear Madame Mayor and Council,

I am writing to voice my concern over the timing of recent traffic counters that were placed on both Hadden Drive and Mathers Avenue. These were set up during the lowest traffic volumes of the entire year. During the summer there are no field hockey games, soccer games, school is not in session and church attendance is always lowest through the summer months. This count is not a true picture of the traffic on these two streets. Who organizes these traffic counts?

In addition, I have concerns over the Bunt Traffic study for the following reasons:

1. Data supplied by the field hockey group for the Bunt study indicated that there would be 2000 users. However, in the MRIF application the number of users referred to is 8400. A very large difference.
2. Peak hours in the study are mentioned but there is no indication of the duration of these hours.
3. The proposed Elliott Court development on Mathers Avenue will have an impact on this study.

I ask that these facts be taken into consideration and that traffic counts be done at a time that is more reflective of what is really happening. I would appreciate a reply.
