Thank You Brent,

1)It seems to me that with four pieces of equipment the District only has capacity to service the primary routes. Also, considering the long term zoning of the higher density Upper Lands, said capacity will remain the same although demand will grow. Furthermore, being located on a cul de sac with a tricky "S" turn, in our view, our District services in winter conditions will exclude snow removal, garbage and recycling services.

2)On the District website it suggests parking cars on collector roads. We have done so for three weeks yet my car has hindered the District's ability to service my Chairlift Road neighbour's access to her property. She has access but she must clear alot more snow. I have copied her in on this e-mail.

Also, our cars are exposed to damage in winter conditions. Neighbours have had damages caused by a late night hit and run at the intersection of Chairlift Road and Chelsea Place.

3)If Chelsea Place is not serviced by Tuesday PM Jan 06 and we still have winter conditions on Wednesday AM Jan 07, I want to take my eight container loads of garbage up to Chairlift Road and Chelse Place for NSRP service.

4)Since, over the long-run, in winter conditions, it seems the District lacks the capacity to service our cul de sac, and knowing that the absence of service affects my neighbours and knowing snowplows retail for CDN\$1000 to CDN\$2000 we want to purchase a snowblower so we can recieve District services in return for a credit on our District taxes.
