Subject: Snow Removal on 18th St. between Queens and Rosebery

I had a pleasant experience today with two district workers. They were in the process of filling a salt barrel at the intersection of 18th street and Rosebery Ave. This part of 18th is short (130 metres) and very steep. I mentioned that years ago there was a second barrel half way up the hill. Imagine my pleasure to come back an hour later to find them placing a second barrel!

However, the real point is that this 130 metre stretch of 18th strands 31 families on Rosebery Ave. when it becomes iced over. It would take about one minute for the plow doing Queens to turn up 18th to Rosebery and back to Queens.

The 31 families can manage Rosebery but not the hill. Would you please consider asking the District Manager to include this part of 18th Ave. with Queens as a priority 1 route?
