I run the seawall on a regular basis, including that portion along Ambleside. There are constantly large puddles of water in sections of the seawall, even after days without rain. The attached photo, which was taken Saturday, August 22<sup>nd</sup> demonstrates what I am talking about. For me, these obstructions are really only a minor (but unnecessary) nuisance, however, for others, in particular those who find it challenging to step up on the wall beside the seawall, these obstructions (and there are many), make passing difficult. In the winter months these sections are often frozen and this creates a treacherous condition for everybody.

The seawall is a wonderful asset for everyone to enjoy, however, improvements to drainage are needed in order to ensure that people can do so in a safe manner. I appreciate your attention to this.
