Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 4414, 2005, Amendment Bylaw No. 4652, 2010

A bylaw to amend fees and charges related to Cemetery Tariffs

Previous amendments: Amendment Bylaws 4431, 4441, 4456, 4461, 4489, 4495, 4502, 4527, 4532, 4537, 4564, 4586, 4589, 4616, 4648, and 4650.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the District of West Vancouver deems it expedient to amend "Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 4414, 2005".

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the District of West Vancouver enacts as follows:

Part 1 Citation

- 1.1 This bylaw may be cited as Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 4414, 2005, Amendment Bylaw No. 4652, 2010

Part 2 Severability

- 2.1 If a portion of this bylaw is held invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion must be severed and the remainder of this bylaw is deemed to have been adopted without the severed section, subsequent, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or phrase.

Part 3 Amendments

- 3.1 Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 4414, 2005 (adopted on February 21, 2005) is to be amended by replacing Schedule 12 Cemetery Tariffs with the attached replacement schedule.

Further Information on Fee Structure

A Rights of Interment Fees for Residents

Note that this does not include open and closing for actual interment in the grave space, markers, liners where required, and other administrative fees

1. **Initial Rights of Interment** *(must be allocated to a person at time of purchase: the person must be named)*
2. **Additional Rights of Interment** where the person is named at the time of the initial purchase only: \$200 per person
3. **Subsequent Rights of Interment** where the person is not named at the time of initial purchase: \$700 per person

B Memorial Fee for in memoriam designations

\$200 in addition to fees for marker setting or re-setting

C Care Fund

All interment rights, in memoriam fees, and memorial marker setting fees are subject pay an additional 25% care fund fee, rounded for administrative simplicity

D Additional Fees for Non-residents

Additional fees for non-residents only apply to the right of interment and associated care fund. The additional fees for non residents are set at 100% of the applicable fees respecting in-ground interment rights and an additional 50% of applicable fees respecting Columbaria interment rights. There are no additional non-resident fees for any family columbaria right of interment, in memoriam fee, open and closing for actual interment in a grave space, markers, liners, or other administrative fees.

The first right of interment to a non-resident for a grave space, triggers the obligation to pay the additional non-resident fees on the initial right of interment purchase. A \$500 rebate applies if a subsequent right of interment (person not named the time of initial purchase) is the first right of interment to a non –resident

for a grave space. The rebate is provided to keep the subsequent conversion to a non-resident grave space more affordable.

For clarity the following examples of using an adult grave space are provided:

Example 1 If the first non-resident right of interment is the initial purchaser:

- Additional non-resident fees of \$3,020 plus the applicable care fund apply (*amount paid by the non resident at this point is \$6,040 plus applicable care fund and taxes*).
- Each additional right of interment named at the time of the initial purchase, if for a non-resident, attracts additional non-resident fees of \$200 plus applicable care fund (*amount paid by the purchaser is \$400 plus the applicable care fund and taxes*).
- Each subsequent rights of interment, if for a non-resident, attracts an additional non-resident fees of \$700 plus applicable care fund (*amount paid by the non-resident is \$1400 plus the applicable care fund and taxes*).

Example 2 If the first non-resident right of interment is an additional right of interment and thus named at time of purchase:

- Additional non-resident fees of \$200 plus \$3020 plus the applicable care fund apply (*amount paid by the purchaser is \$6040 and \$400 plus the applicable care fund and taxes*).
- Same as previous example: Each additional right of interment named at the time of the initial purchase, if for a non-resident, attracts additional non-resident fees of \$200 plus applicable care fund (*amount paid by the purchaser is \$400 plus the applicable care fund and taxes*).
- Same as previous example: Each subsequent rights of interment, if for a non-resident, attracts an additional non-resident fees of \$700 plus applicable care fund (*amount paid by the non-resident is \$1400 plus the applicable care fund and taxes*).

Example 3 If the first non-resident right of interment is a subsequent right of interment and therefore not named at the time of purchase:

- Additional non-resident fees of \$200 for a subsequent interment right, plus \$3020 for the additional non-resident fees on the initial right of interment purchase, plus the applicable care fund apply. The subsequent right of interment fee, normally \$700 has had a rebate of \$500 applied thus the overall fee is reduced to \$200 as is the consequent non-resident fee (*amount paid by the non-resident is \$6040 and \$400 plus the applicable care fund and taxes*).
- Each subsequent rights of interment, if for a non-resident, attracts an additional non-resident fees of \$700 plus applicable care fund (*amount paid by the non-resident is \$1400 plus the applicable care fund and taxes*)

F Additional Information

A resident can be a:

- property owner in the District of West Vancouver
- spouse or dependent child of property owner in the District of West Vancouver
- resident elector, who is someone who meets ALL of the following requirements: older than 17 years old and is a Canadian citizen and is a resident of BC for at least 6 months and a resident of the District of West Vancouver for at least 30 days.
- spouse or dependent child of resident elector (a spouse of a resident elector would very likely be a resident elector themselves. A dependent child of a resident elector would not themselves be a resident elector because they would not be 18 years of age. Upon turning 18 and not being dependent, they would become a resident elector provided they met the residency requirements).

Family members are allowed to be interred together

Family includes a parent or stepparent, grandparent or stepgrandparent, sibling (natural, adopted or step), spouse, child (natural, adopted or step), or grandchild (natural, adopted or step).
