  - (k) negotiations and related discussions respecting the proposed provision of a municipal service that are at their preliminary stages and that, in the view of the council, could reasonably be expected to harm the interests of the municipality if they were held in public.

Tutsch spoke relative to the Library's accomplishments over the past five years, 2010 community survey results, purpose and development of the Strategic Plan, input from the Strategic Planning Working Group, the Library's mission and vision statement, and strategic priorities.

Discussion ensued and Councillor Panz commented on the development of the Strategic Plan, noted that the Plan is available on the Library's website, and informed of the upcoming Friends of the Library annual book sale on April 8 and 9, 2011.

Councillor Panz reported on the blue trees exhibit, to raise awareness of deforestation, on the Grosvenor property at the former Imperial Oil site at Marine Drive and 14<sup>th</sup> Street, informed that 2011 is the United Nations International Year of Forests, and commented relative to West Vancouver's forested lands and the related work of Council and the Parks Working Group, and speaking this week at the United Nations about West Vancouver's low carbon initiatives.

Mayor Goldsmith-Jones announced that April is Child Abuse Prevention month, noted the blue ribbons that Council is wearing provided by Doris Paul, Squamish Nation, noted that Doris Paul, who leads the Caring for our Youth Committee, was recognized by Premier Campbell with the provincial BC Community Achievement Award, and commented regarding improving connections with the Squamish Nation around the things that West Vancouver and the Squamish Nation share in common. Mayor Goldsmith-Jones informed that Dr. Darryl Plecas (RCMP University Research Chair in Crime Reduction, at the University of the Fraser Valley) attended last week's Police Board meeting, and regarding West Vancouver's decline in crime, informed of his plans to research the West Vancouver Police Department's crime reduction strategy and crime analysis, and commented relative to the hard work of the Police Department to keep crime rate low.
