Water Shortage Response Plan Bylaw No. 4418, 2005 Amendment Bylaw No. 4690, 2011

A bylaw to amend the watering restrictions schedules

Previous amendments: Amendment Bylaw 4521, 2007

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the District of West Vancouver deems it expedient to amend "Water Shortage Response Plan Bylaw No. 4418, 2005";

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the District of West Vancouver enacts as follows:

Part 1 Citation

- 1.1 This bylaw may be cited as Water Shortage Response Plan Bylaw No. 4418, 2005, Amendment Bylaw No. 4690, 2011.

Part 2 Severability

- 2.1 If a portion of this bylaw is held invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion must be severed and the remainder of this bylaw is deemed to have been adopted without the severed section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or phrase.

Part 3 Amendment

- 3.1 Water Shortage Response Plan Bylaw No. 4418, 2005 is amended by:

- 3.1.1 Part 3 Definitions: adding the following definitions in 3.1 and reordering alphabetically as follows:

"Non Residential" means any building unit(s) other than residential housing, such as office buildings, shops, industrial units, churches, or hotels. In cases of mixed use, where commercial or industrial components are included in the same property along with residential, and subject to the landscaping being watered by an in-ground sprinkling system, the designation shall then be classified as "Non Residential."

"Residential" means a dwelling unit used for residential purposes.

- 3.1.2 In Schedule A – Restriction Stages, Part 1 Stage 1 Restrictions: deleting Section 1.1 (a) (i) (ii), and replacing with a new Section 1.1 (a) as follows:
- (a) Water Lawns, except:
 - (i) at Residential addresses: even numbered addresses – Monday, Wednesday and Saturday mornings (4:00 am – 9:00 am), odd numbered addresses – Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday mornings (4:00 am – 9:00 am);
 - (ii) at Non-Residential addresses: even numbered addresses – Monday and Wednesday mornings (1:00 am – 6:00 am), odd numbered addresses – Tuesday and Thursday mornings (1:00 am – 6:00 am). All non-residential addresses – Friday mornings (4:00 am – 9:00 am).
- 3.1.3 In Schedule A – Restriction Stages, Part 1 Stage 1 Restrictions, adding the words “and municipal parks” to Section 1.2 (b) (i).
- 3.1.4 In Schedule A – Restriction Stages, Part 1 Stage 1 Restrictions, adding (d) to Section 1.2 as follows:
- (d) filling of pools, spas, water play parks, and fountains.
- 3.1.5 In Schedule A – Restriction Stages, Part 2 Stage 2 Restrictions: deleting Section 2.1 (a) (i) (ii) and replacing it with a new Section 2.1 (a) as follows:
- (a) Water Lawns, except:
 - (i) at Residential addresses: even-numbered addresses -Monday mornings only (4:00 am – 9:00 am), odd-numbered addresses -Thursday mornings only (4:00 am – 9:00 am);
 - (ii) at Non-Residential addresses: even-numbered addresses – Wednesday mornings only (1:00 am – 6:00 am), odd-numbered addresses – Tuesday mornings only (1:00 am – 6:00 am).

3.1.6 In Schedule B – Information for Public Announcement of Stage 1 Restrictions: deleting bullet point one and two and replacing it with:

- That lawn sprinkling is allowed only from 1:00 am – 9:00 am.
- That residential, even-numbered addresses may sprinkle only on Monday, Wednesday and Saturday mornings between 4:00 am – 9:00 am. Residential, odd-numbered addresses may sprinkle only on Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday mornings between 4:00 am – 9:00 am. Non-residential, even numbered addresses may sprinkle only on Monday and Wednesday mornings between 1:00 am – 6:00 am. Non-residential, odd numbered addresses may sprinkle only on Tuesday and Thursday mornings between 1:00 am – 6:00 am. All non-residential addresses may sprinkle on Friday mornings between 4:00 am – 9:00 am.

3.1.7 In Schedule C – Information for Public Announcement of Stage 2 Restrictions: deleting bullet point one and two and replacing it with:

- That lawn sprinkling is allowed only from 1:00 am – 9:00 am.
- That residential, even-numbered addresses may sprinkle only on Monday mornings between 4:00 am – 9:00 am. Residential, odd-numbered addresses may sprinkle only on Thursday mornings between 4:00 am – 9:00 am. Non-residential, even-numbered addresses may sprinkle only on Wednesday mornings between 1:00 am – 6:00 am. Non-residential, odd-numbered addresses may sprinkle only on Tuesday mornings between 1:00 am – 6:00 am.
