**1. CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order at 3 p.m.

**2. WORKSHOP**

Facilitated by Working Group member P. Ulveland, the group summarized the discussions from the previous workshop held August 12. Discussion continued on the previously identified issues, including continued consideration on draft solutions for Building Size.

The group discussed the findings from their workshops conducted between July 31 through August 21. Members concluded that the longer-format workshop was a successful approach to move their consideration from issues to potential solutions. The Working Group proceeded to develop an approach to refine the previously identified solutions. Members considered solutions for housing diversity in greater detail.

It also reviewed the fall schedule, including potential times to engage the building industry for input. The group identified early December as a potential time for public consultation.

Returning to the typical meeting format, the Working Group scheduled a meeting for Wednesday, September 4, from 4pm – 7pm.


**3. ADJOURNMENT**
