1. CALL TO ORDER

The workshop was called to order at 11 a.m.

2. WORKSHOP

Facilitated by Working Group members P. Ulveland and S. Chunick, the group brainstormed ideas for overarching outcomes for the five previously identified issues: Building Size; Landscaping; Hard Surfaces; Neighbour/Public Interface; and Housing Diversity. Members recorded individual ideas on boards, reviewed and consolidated these comments, and refined the outcome statements through group discussion.

Following the determination of overarching outcomes, the Working Group proceeded to identify sub-problems for each issue.



The group identified an approach to consider the remaining issues and scheduled a continuation of the workshop for Friday, August 9, from 10am – 3pm.


3. ADJOURNMENT
