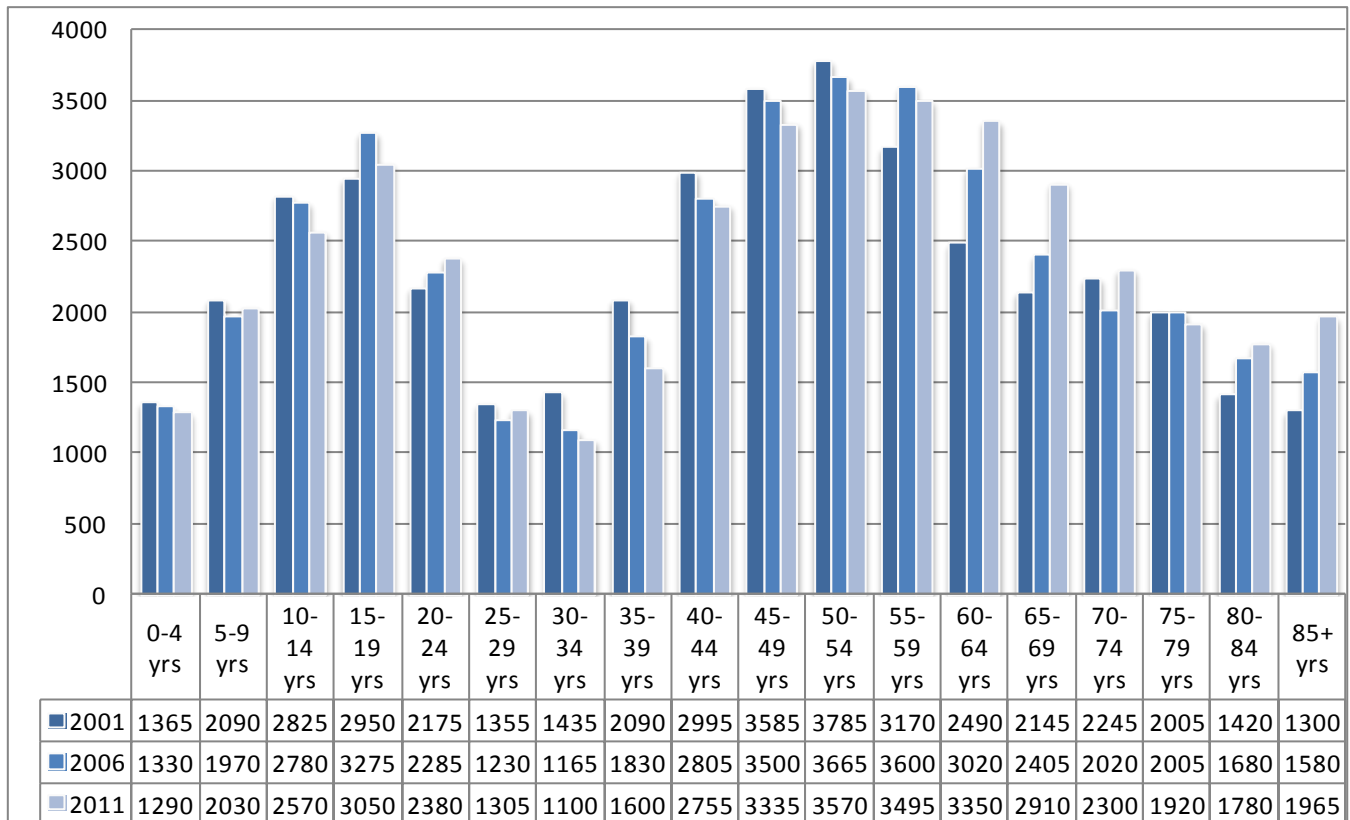

Data from the 2011 census indicates that the aging trend in West Vancouver has continued. Compared to earlier census years, there are more people age 60+ and a slight increase in the number of young adults (20-29 yrs). There was a decline in the number of adults age 30-59 and in the number of children/youth age 10-19. As of the 2011 census, 25% of West Vancouver's population were age 65+ (compared to 13.5% in Metro Vancouver).

The median age in West Vancouver continues to increase, and in 2011 was 49.9 (compared to 40.2 in Metro Vancouver).
