Road Closure and Removal of Highway Dedication Bylaw No. 4838, 2015

A bylaw to close up and remove the dedication of a portion of highway adjacent to 4435 Stone Crescent, West Vancouver

WHEREAS:

- A) under the *Community Charter* the Council of the District of West Vancouver may close a highway to traffic, remove the dedication of a highway and dispose of municipal land;
- B) the Council has posted and published notices of its intention to close the portion of highway referred to in this bylaw and remove its dedication as highway, and has provided an opportunity for persons who consider they are affected to make representations to Council;
- C) the Council does not consider that the closure will affect the transmission or distribution facilities or works of utility operators;
- D) the Council has posted and published notices of its intention to dispose of the portion of highway referred to in this bylaw for the purposes of consolidation with the adjacent property located at 4435 Stone Crescent; and
- E) the Council deems it expedient to provide for the closure to traffic and removal of the dedication of that portion of highway adjacent to 4435 Stone Crescent, West Vancouver and more particularly described in this bylaw; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the District of West Vancouver enacts as follows:

Part 1 Citation

- 1.1 This bylaw may be cited as Road Closure and Removal of Highway Dedication Bylaw No. 4838, 2015.

Part 2 Severability

- 2.1 If a portion of this bylaw is held invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion must be severed and the remainder of this bylaw is deemed to have been adopted without the severed section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or phrase.

Part 3 Road Closure and Removal of Highway Dedication

- 3.1 That portion of highway dedicated by Plan 9350 identified as “Closed Road” on the plan dated 21 April, 2015 (the “Closed Road”), a reduced copy of which is attached to this bylaw as Schedule A and which forms part of this bylaw, is closed to all types of traffic.
- 3.2 The dedication as highway of the Closed Road is removed.
- 3.3 The Mayor and Clerk are authorized to execute and deliver such transfers, deeds of land, plans and other documents as are necessary or desirable to effect the aforesaid closure and removal of highway dedication.
